TALK IT OVER

READ & DISCUSS

- How is your prayer life (honestly)? Do you think of prayer as something burdensome or optional? Powerful and beautiful, bringing you into the presence of God? Something in between?
- What is most surprising about Jesus' prayer in John 17? What is most challenging? What is most encouraging?
- Who do you pray for the most? Who are "your people" you should be lifting up more regularly? How could you pray more intentionally for the lost (those YET to believe)?
- "Glory" is something we all long for, to some degree. We want to be part of something greater than ourselves, to experience excellence, wonder and impact outside the norm. How does a particular understanding of "glory" shape Jesus' prayer? How might it shape ours?

SING & PRAY

Sing "Before the Throne of God Above" with your family this week.
